

EXPANDED ABSENTEE BALLOTING OPPORTUNITY -- PPRESIDENTIAL PRIMARY

Due to the Coronavirus epidemic and the potential for the virus to be lingering in our community and with concern for the health and safety of Poll Inspectors and Voters, Absentee Balloting in the June 23rd Presidential Primary is strongly encouraged. This opportunity is only available for the June 23rd primary.

- An application is being sent to all registered Democrats and **a postage paid return envelope** will be provided. It must be completed and returned.
- For all valid applications, an absentee ballot will be sent out prior to the election and **a postage paid return envelope** will be provided the voter.
- Balloting instructions will be provided with the ballot.
- All absentee ballots must be mailed on or before June 22nd.
